IDEOGRAPHIC writing is the art of expressing ideas by means of images or pictures, and is the natural language of children and primitive men everywhere. The most perfect examples of this writing have been found in Egypt, and have been known as the hieroglyphs.

They also address questions of what constitutes good historical writing and why it is especially important to develop such writing skills today.
